Notes to the accounts for the year to 31 October 2019

1. Accounting Policy

These accounts comprise a Statement of Receipts and Payments and a Statement of Balances. They have been prepared in accordance with the Charities & Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended).

2. Restricted Funds

The Society has two Restricted Funds - for the Doocot Project and for the Kirkyard Project.

3. Acting as Agent

The Trustees agreed during 2017/18 to act temporarily as agent for Crail Community Partnership which has similar objects to the Society and was in the process of becoming a charity in its own right. The Partnership duly became a charity with its own bank account and, on 28th May 2019, the Society transferred all of the money it was holding on behalf of the Partnership (a total of £12,026.52) to the new charity. This brought the agency agreement to an end.

6. Grants Received

The Doocot Restricted Fund received grants of £6,000 from the NE Fife Common Good Fund and £5,560 from National Heritage Lottery. There was an additional grant of £1,125 from Paths for All in relation to the proposals for Denburn Park.

The Society has no investments.

12. Heritable Property

The Society Committee is of the opinion that the properties owned by the Society have an indefinite life and that their aggregate value is considerably in excess of cost, the value used in the Financial Statements. Any depreciation charge would be inappropriate, therefore. The Society has a policy and practice of regular maintenance and repair such that the heritable properties are kept in a condition to retain their value. The Society Committee is of the opinion that its properties are held primarily to further the objects of the Society, not as investment properties, and they are shown in the Financial Statements at cost for this reason.
